LCCF in Hobbs is still struggling to get going and I am asking for prayers that God will bring leaders and new volunteers to that ministry. They have been a staple in Kairos in NM for years and I am praying that God will open that door soon.

Pay Attention to who shows up for you!

We all have times in our lives where we have ups and downs. When we are on the mountain top and in the Valley low.

Who shows up for all the important details of your life? For the milestones to celebrate life's big moments when you need uplifting, when you need to cry, when you lose loved ones, when you are dealing with downfalls, or during joyous times.

Who shows up for you?

JESUS had many following HIM, there were some in HIS life when HE was in human form that were there, but did they show up for HIM?

In Verses Matthew 4:18-22, and Matthew 9:9 we read about some of the disciples dropping everything to follow JESUS. As this is what we all should do, correct? But even when they dropped everything to follow JESUS, where they faithful to him? Where they there when HE needed them?

Matthew 26:14-25, 47-51 Talks about Judas Iscariot and how JESUS called him out during the last supper letting Judas know that HE knows HE is about to be betrayed and who is going to do it.
